
Fair Processing Notice





Rod Mill Fatality Barry Shaw

- Saturday 28th August 2010, Scunthorpe, UK
- What happened:
 - Driver Barry Shaw came to collect a loaded trailer
 - He dropped his empty trailer and then reversed under the loaded trailer
 - Engine was running. Handbrake was **NOT** applied
 - Tractor and trailer rolled away
 - Driver tried to get back into the tractor unit to stop it.
 - Driver was crushed to death
- Learnings
 - Standard:
 - Truck Handbrake must be applied
 - Engine off
 - Keys out
 - Apply trailer park brake








No Climbing!!





Strap Condition



Lashing Capacity 2000 daN – This is 2ton of Force NOT Weight!

The webbing has been cut and has a frayed edge. This will weaken the webbing substantially



The webbing has been cut across its width by a sharp edge. This type of damage will result in substantial loss of strength.



Knotted webbing should not be used. A cut lashing should not be joined by knotting.








